
## **Creating a Simple Animation Step by Step**


- 1. Open Dreamweaver
- 2. Open the Site Manager
- 3. Create an empty test site
- 4. Create an empty folder for image File
- 5. Create and open a new file




6. Create a Layer to hold the element to be animated

Open the Insert Tool Bar and Drag the Layer Icon to the desk Top Or. Click on the Layer Icon then click and drag out a layer on the desk top

Or. Insert from the main tool bar




7. The layer can then be position on the screen and resized Numerically
Or by clicking and dragging




8. Select and insert your image into the layer:

From the main tool bar > Insert > Image

Keyboard short cut **Ctrl+Alt+I** 








Use a transparent Gif image to remove the background if required.

## **Adding the Timeline**

10. Open the *Timeline Window*From the main tool bar > <u>W</u>indow > <u>Timelines</u>
Or Shift + F9



11. Add the layer to the timeline by:

Dragging the layer onto the Timelines Window.

## Note:


The layer order is created by the order items are place in the timeline. Adjust settings numerically or by clicking and dragging.


Note: The Warning.

12. To create a Fly-in, we start at the finish.

Move the timeline Playback Head to the end


- 13. Click to select end point.
- 14. Reselect the Start point.
- 15. With the start point selected move the layer off screen.

Use the numeric settings in the properties inspector to position the layer out of sight off screen.

## Tip


Add the <u>L</u> 151px + W 200px = 351 px

Therefore insert a minus -351> and the image will be off screen to the left.



15. Select the Autoplay Tick Box Note the Dialog Box below!

**16. Save and Test** Keyboard shortcut > **Shift** + **S** > **F12** to load in Browser
